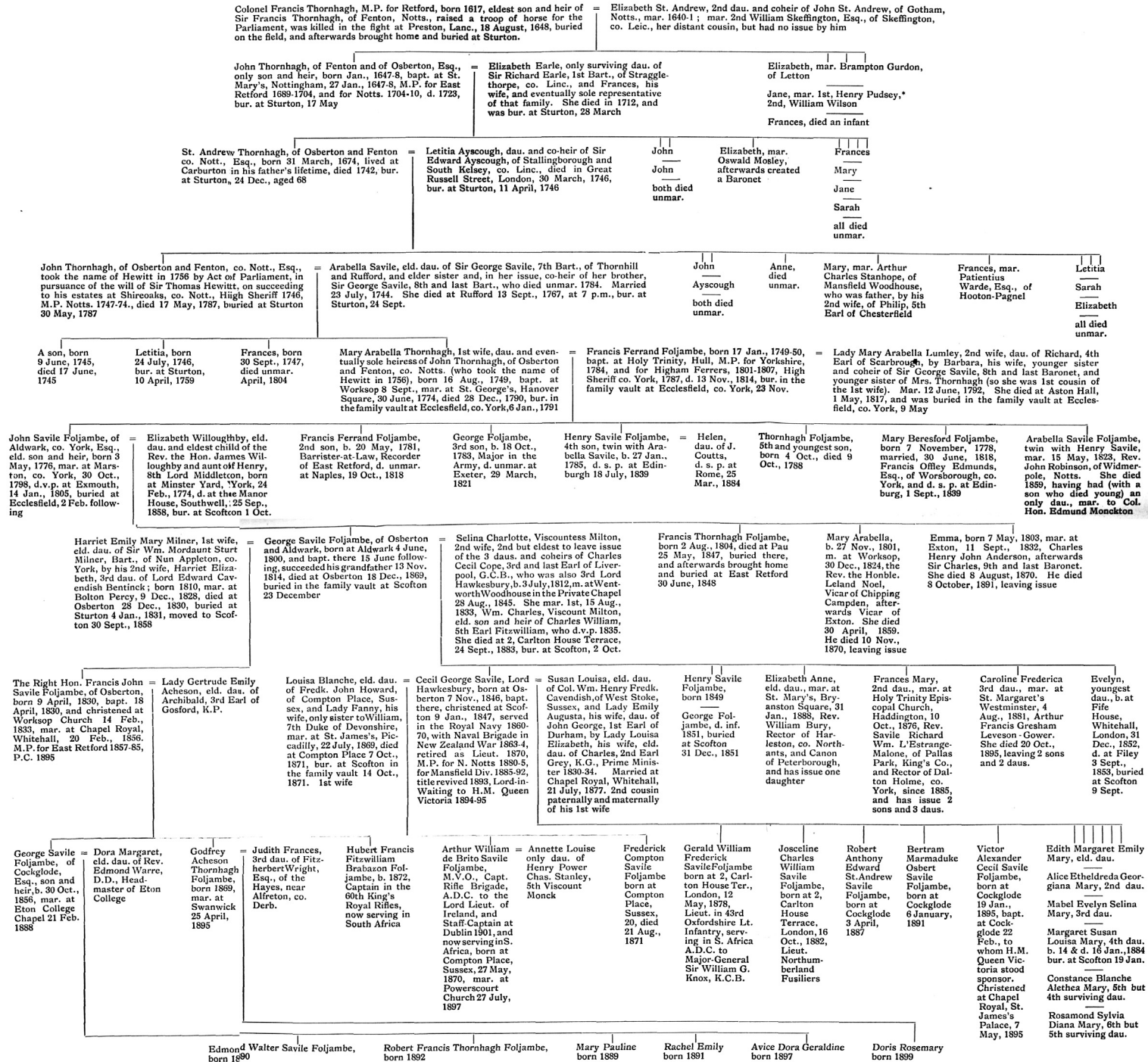


PEDIGREE OF THORNHAGH, as far as it relates to Osberton.

Arms of THORNHAGH:—Argent, a gimmel ring gules between three crosses pattée sable. Crest:—A tiger's head or, maned armed and tufted sable, gorged with a collar wavy azure. Old Crest:—A hawthorn tree flowered and fruited proper.
Arms of FOLJAMBE:—Sable, a bend between six escallops or. Crest:—A man's leg unarmed, couped at the thigh, quarterly or and sable, spurred gold.
